Submission Guidelines and Review Criteria

Participants should submit research statement based on the themes of the colloquium in no more than 1000 words and not less than 750 words. All statements will be blind reviewed and only those approved by the reviewers will be selected. The research statement submitted must give a clear indication of the objective, methodology, major results, implications, and key references. Willing participants may submit their full length paper for the edited book within the stipulated time, once the research statement is accepted.

The criteria for evaluation by the reviewers are as follows:

Relevance: Does the subject of the research appeal to the interest of the colloquium attendees?

Methodology: Does the research work use appropriate method(s)?

Originality: Does the research work add new findings, insights, or knowledge to the body of literature?

Conclusions: Are the conclusions sound and justified as per the problem discussion?

Note: Please follow the format as per Annexure-I & II for the research statement and full length paper need to be submitted in MS Word.

Full Length Paper: Submission Guidelines and Formatting

Submission Rules for Full Length Paper:

- Submitted papers must NOT have been previously presented, scheduled for presentation, published, or sent for publication elsewhere. Contributions should be prepared specifically for this conference.
- NO changes in the paper title, abstract, authorship, and actual paper can occur AFTER the submission deadline.
- Please note that deadline for FULL LENGTH SUBMISSION is February 15-16, 2019

Formatting of the Full Length Paper:

Please follow these guidelines to ensure your paper is reviewed.

Note: Papers that are not prepared according to these formatting instructions will NOT be reviewed.

- The entire paper (title page, abstract, body, figures, tables, references, etc.) must be in ONE document using Microsoft Word (.DOC) formats:

The maximum length of the paper is 10 pages (including title page, ALL tables, appendices, and references). *Papers exceeding this limit will be returned to their corresponding author.*

Pages should be numbered in the page footer (center), including the first page. Papers should be organized in the following sequence:

- Title of the paper, name(s) of the author(s), affiliation(s)
 - Abstract
 - Keywords
 - Main subject text
 - Acknowledgments (when applicable)
 - References

- The format for tables and figures, references, and appendices should follow the ***IIE Transactions Journal's Style Guide*** (formerly known as *IIE transaction*).
 - Use Times New Roman 12-point font, double spaced, 1-inch (2.5 cm) margin all around, and 8.5" × 11" page setting. References may be single spaced.
 - Check that the paper prints correctly (i.e., all imported figures and tables appear) and ensure that the file is virus-free.
